

II. METHODOLOGY

Data collection for the movie "*Little Women (2019)*" was conducted using the observation method. The process involved several steps. First, watching the movie attentively, paying close attention to detail. Next, creating a comprehensive list of data specifically related to the main character. This data was collected by observing scenes and dialogue involving the main character. Then, also noting the conflicts and the personality type of the main character that appears in each conflict by referring to specific scenes and duration in the movie. Finally, the collected information was sorted into groups based on the main character's conflicts and personality type. In the analysis, the data collected include scenes which are supported by script. After the data is collected, the conditions for the type of conflict can be identified by utilizing Kenney's theory (1966) and analyzing the personality type of the main character proposed by Freud (1923).
